DUAL EDUCATION PROGRAM

We believe that education is the key that opens the doors to the future. At Sky Adventures in Costa Rica, we strive to positively impact the lives of children, adolescents, and young people in the region by supporting their development so they can reach their full potential.

In a strong step toward the future, we established a strategic alliance with the National Institute of Learning (INA) through the signing of an agreement for Dual Education in Adventure Tourism Guiding on Cables and Ropes, from which 5 people graduated in 2024.























SKY EDUCATION PROGRAM

With a firm commitment to strengthening education in our region, we launched the "Sky Education" program, which included the development of a comprehensive assessment tool for evaluating local educational institutions. As a result, we selected three schools to support with significant infrastructure improvements.



COMMUNITY SERVICE

In 2024, we increased our community service hours, reaching a total of 107 hours of volunteer work.

We carried out various volunteer initiatives, ranging from cleanup days in nearby communities which allowed us to collect 60 kg of waste from green areas and public spaces—to our participation in several social projects.

These included building a playground for the Escuela del Castillo, responding to climate emergencies, maintaining trees planted during reforestation campaigns, providing environmental education, and supporting community festivals.






BIOLOGICAL INVENTORY

This strategic partnership will allow us to deepen our knowledge of the ecosystem, implement




